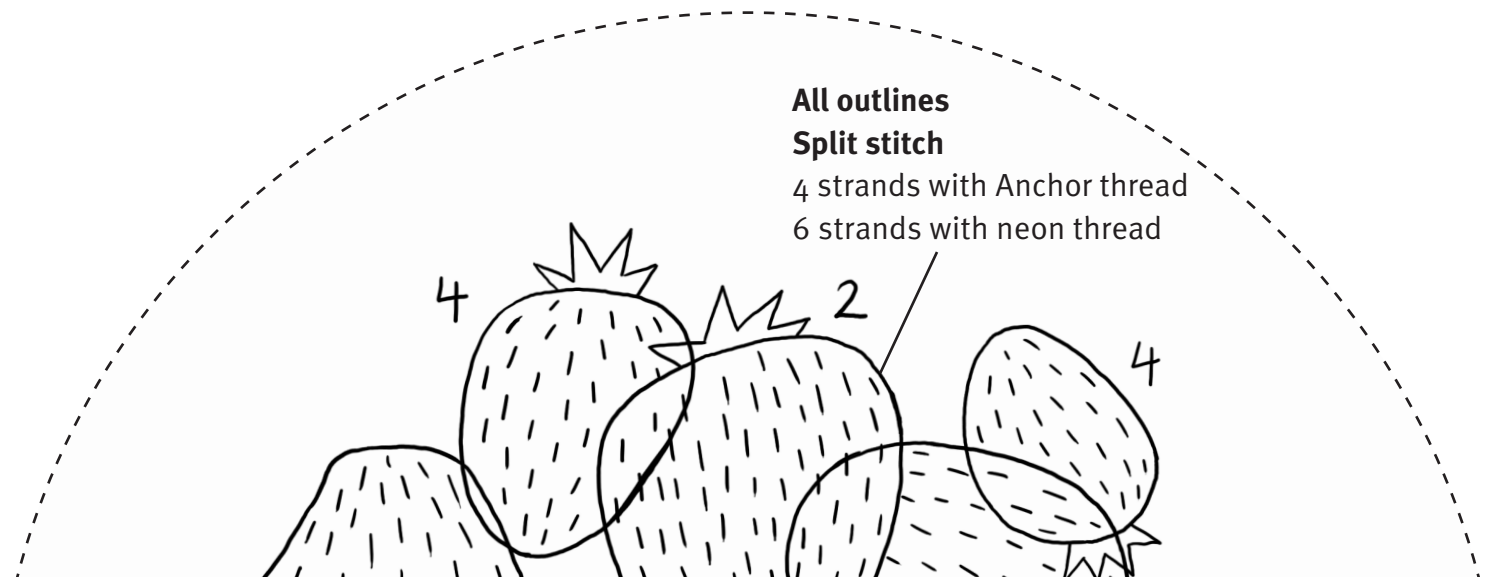


Tutorial on blue

Stitches and colours

Use back stitch, running stitch and split stitch. The stitches are explained on page 5.

Start stitching with the strawberries from layer 4, this is the undermost layer. Strawberry no. 1 is the top-most layer and is stitched at the end.

Strand colours from Anchor:

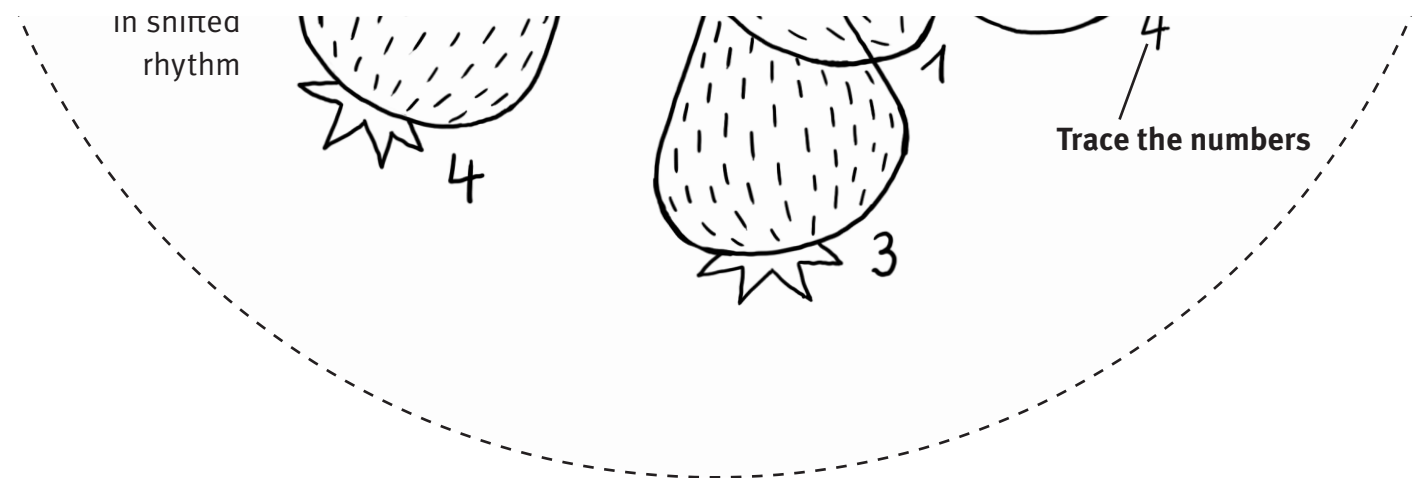
Layer 4: violett 111

Layer 3: neonorange 949 from Rico

Layer 2: red 00046

Layer 1: neonpink 950 from Rico

Leaves: petrol 00187 and
neongreen 948 from Rico



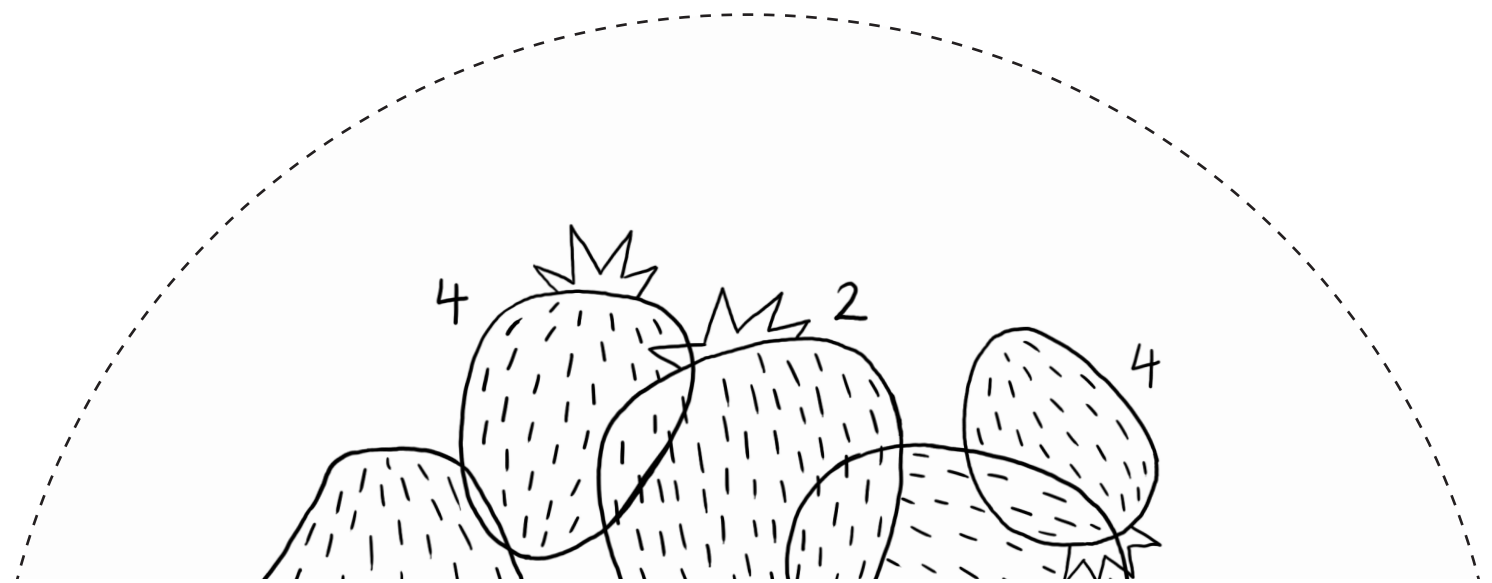
Artwork

Set the printer to „real size“ or set the scaling to 100%.

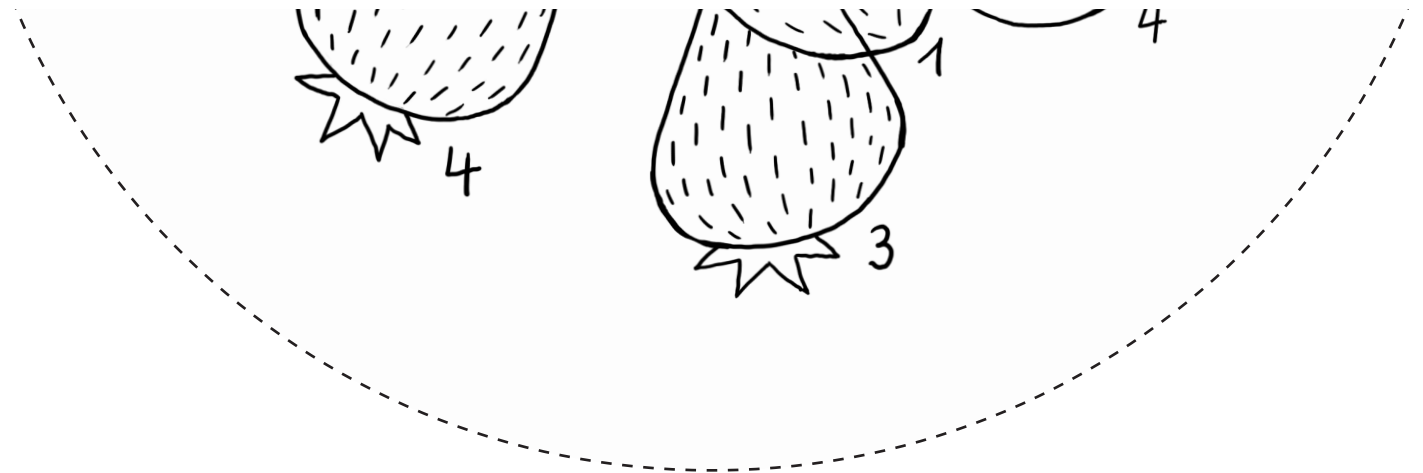
Print for other framesizes:

Mathematical formula to adapt the scaling for other framesizes



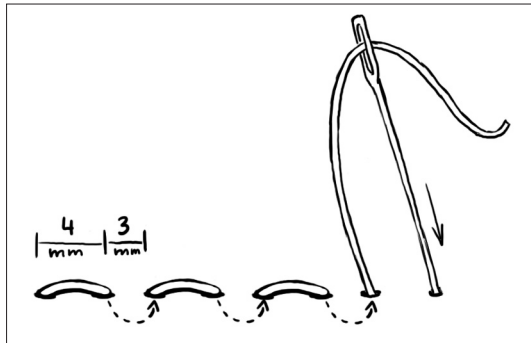

If you scale the motive up, please consider that the number of strands should also get more.



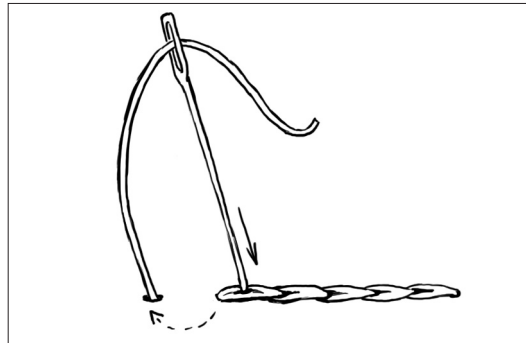
How to do the stitches

Running stitch



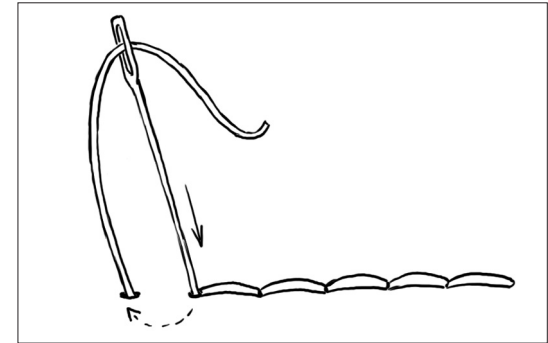
Place a stitch with length 4 mm, then go down and come up in a distance that is smaller, e.g. 3 mm. Place the next stitch with 4 mm again.

Split stitch



Move the needle bottom up through the fabric in same distance like the stitch before. From up you stitch directly in the strand of the

Move the needle bottom up through the fabric in same distance like the stitch before. Then put the needle to the hole at the end of the
