GARDA Vest

The GARDA Vest is knitted with raglan from top to bottom and without seam. It is started with an I-CORD cast on. This is explained with corresponding pictures. After the neckline and the raglan have been knitted, the armholes are binded off and the body is knitted. Except for the armholes, each edge gets an I-CORD edging. The GARDA Vest is constructed in such a way that it is not necessary to pick up stitches from the edge to create the I-CORD edging.

The I-CORD on the button bar is knitted in every row and the I-CORD on the bottom is created by casting off with I-CORD.

Since my first attempt at this vest was knitted at Lake Garda, the vest is named after this beautiful spot on earth.
