## "Cat with little kittens"

knitting pattern Ola_Oslopova


## Materials

The size of the finished toy depends on the yarn you choose. If you want to make a toy, which is larger or smaller than indicated in the pattern, You should take thicker or thinner yarn. The amount of yarn You will need also depends on the yarn chosen.

Yarn (you will need about 40g)
-Alize Alpaca Royal" 55\% Acrylic 30\% Alpaka 15\% Wool $250 \mathrm{~m} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ (white)- for a cat
-Super bebe $100 \%$ premium acrylic $180 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ (pink)- for a cat
-Alize Angora Cold $80 \%$ Akrilik 20\% Wool $550 \mathrm{~m} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ \#55- for kittens
-pink and gray yam - for decoration

- fiberfill (sintepon or hollow fiber)
-sewing needle
-2.0 mm straight knitting needles (US 0)
-brown threads for eyes details
-1.0 mm crochet hook (US 10)
The finished toy measures about 17 cm ( 6.6 inches) (without tail) in length and 8 cm (3.1 inches) in width in case of using the materials listed.
The finished kittens measures about 7 cm (2,7 inches) high in case of using the materials listed.


## Recommendations

-bind the stitches using any convenient way -yarn over means we increase from the horizontal bar between stitches -m1- increase from the horizontal bar between the stitches (twist when working this stitch)

## Abbreviations (US terminology)

st, sts - stitch, stitches
R - row
k - knit
p - purl
k2tog - knit two together
p2tog - purl two together
kfb - knit front then back loops of the same stitch
*-repeat
