



Ripple stitch sweater kids – American crochet pattern:

This cheerful sweater is made with the ripple stitch and gradient yarn and is available in 5 sizes (4 - 12 years). Crochet this sweater with a cotton blend for the summer or a wool mix for the winter. The sleeves are not full length, but you can easily make the sleeves longer with the explanation in the pattern.

Information:

- This crochet pattern is written with American crochet terms
- This sweater consists of 4 parts: a front and back piece and 2 sleeves. You have to close the shoulder seams and the side seams and you have to sew or crochet the sleeves into the sweater
- The front and back are identical
- Each size is described separately
- Starting chain stitches of a row do not count as a stitch

Gauge: 1 ripple of 12 stitches = 6.5 cm / 2.6 inch wide and 9.5 rows = 10 cm / 4 inch high

Level: intermediate

Materials:

- Crochet hook US G 6 (= 4 mm)
- Gradient yarn with yarn weight DK / Light worsted (e.g. Lang Yarns Merino 120 color or Lana Grossa Elastico print)
- For sizes and amount of yarn see chart below

Used stitches: CH = Chain, DC = Double Crochet, HDC = Half Double Crochet, SC= Single Crochet, SLST = Slipstitch, INC = Increase = crochet 2DC in 1 stitch, DEC = Decrease = crochet 2DC together
