

Sewing instructions

- 1 - Sewing the pockets

If you do not sew pockets, go to [step 7 on page 10](#). If you do not add a finishing strip to the opening of the pockets, go directly to step 3.

Cut a strip of ribbing or jersey 3.5 cm - 1 ³/₈ " wide and long enough for the opening of the pocket. The length must be cut in the stretchiest direction. Fold the strip in half widthwise, wrong sides together. Pin it to the edge of the pocket while stretching it, opening edges of the strip against the edge of the fabric. (1)

Stitch the stretched strip 1 cm - 3/8 " from the edge. Repeat these steps for the second pocket. (2)



Pin the pockets on the front, right sides together. Place the pins on the side of the front if you have sewn finishing strips. (3)

Stitch the pockets along the opening, stitching over the previous seam if applicable. (4)
