

VIRGINIA BAG



#SOBREVIRGINIA

Virginia is a thick canvas shoulder bag with a simple and sleek design. The bag features two front pockets that are each big enough to welcome a small laptop or tablet. The main compartment of the bag will be perfect to carry a laptop, notebooks and other things of your daily life. The bag has a shoulder strap and a crossbody strap. The bag is made from a cotton fabric that is very durable and has a great texture. It's perfect for carrying your keys, jeans, cards and other little items. 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MATERIALS

1. A canvas or sturdy fabric measuring 130x75 cm. You can use wax cloth or even upholstery fabric for this. I chose a muted cotton canvas (unbleached) that was thick enough without being too dense.


2. Thread in the color of your choice. I bought two threads a mm thick for the bias and a mm thick for the rest. You may also want to use a much thicker thread than the one I used for the waistband if you like to render the thread more visible.

3. Bias or binding tape.

4. A fastener and a D-ring.

5. For the handle:
- a cotton belt (4cm wide),
- some sort of leather rings used to adapt the handle length are double loop silver and one single loop silver.

6. I used velcro to secure the inner pocket. Not vital.



CUTTING & MARKING

PRINTING
Print in actual size.
Bag is only printing the page which contains the test issues in order to check that the measurements are correct.

CUTTING
Cut out all the parts.
The seam allowances are included.
For the base:
1) 30 cm (5 cm sewing allowance at both extremes included).
2) 110 cm (here again, 5 cm sewing allowance at both extremes included).
Cut two strips for the D-ring and the fastener.

MARKING
Make a notch in the fabric by following the lines below right and mark the small rings below left.

TUTORIAL

1. THE INNER POCKET



1.1 Take the inner pocket. Turn the hem at the top and at the bottom. Turn the fabric around and fold the bias. Then, starting the inner pocket. Turn the bias on the sides. This is what the result looks like:



2. THE FRONT



2.1 Take the front pocket. First, turn the hem. Then, mark the bias with the bias. Cut two strips for the D-ring and the fastener.

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2.2 You are now going to sew the front pocket and the base of the bag. Draw the lines where the pocket will be. Sew along these lines (plus where the pocket is).

2.3 The pockets and the base are held together by three central points only. Sew them together on the three sides, in the seam allowance.

3. THE BASE

3.1 You are now going to assemble the base and the back and the base. Sew like on the picture.



3.2 Fold.


3.3 Draw the line of the inner fold (if necessary). Sew.

3.4 Repeat the operation with the base and the front base. Iron, draw, repeat it.



3.5 We are now working on the angles of the base.

3.6 Here's what the result looks like.



3.7 Repeat the operation on the other side. See from the outside, here's the result.

3.8 See the sides of the bag together. Here's the result when you look inside the bag.



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
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

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

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
