Which size should I choose?

Dress "Noa" has a comfortable fit - not too loose and not too tight. If you are unsure about your size use the following sizing chart (finished garment) for orientation. Size of the finished garment:

Stitch the outer seam of the pockets (here you can use your serger / overlock).



Fold the front part of your side pocket to the back, so the ribbing becomes visible. You can now fix the pocket by stitching with an elastic stitch close to the edge of the ribbing.



Turn the front part of your dress bottom so the wrong side is up. Here you can see how both front parts of the pockets need to be applied. Now place the back parts of your pockets onto the front parts (right sides together). Fix them at the outer edge.
