# SHOULDER BAG "FRED"

• Sewing pattern & instructions •



## PRINTING THE PATTERN

Our pattern sheets are in DIN A4 format. They can be printed with every printer. Please make sure to print the page at 100% without scaling it down before printing. To check the correct size you find a small square on page 1 of the pattern which you can measure after printing. If its size is 1 cm x 1 cm, you've chosen the correct printing settings.

## SUPPLIES

You can use either cotton fabrics as well as cork fabric, canvas, faux leather, linen or corduroy.

- Fabric for outside (color 1): 64 cm x 40 cm
- Fabric for outside (color 2): 64 cm x 15 cm
- Fabric for inside: 100 cm x 72 cm
- Fusable interlining H250: 100 cm x 140 cm
- 2 D-rings und 1 slider for a 25mm belt strap
- 146cm belt strap 25 mm or cotton fabric 7 cm x 146 cm
- Fastener: 1 snap button (i.e. kam snap) or press lock
- 2 x 20 cm zipper (zip per metre) with zipper-pull
- tailors chalk or trick marker, ruler
- seam ripper or nail scissors
- optional: hole punch pliers for using book screws & 4 book screws
- thin rounded wooden stick for turning

## Sewing instructions

You need the following pattern pieces:

### Outside top

- 2 x Fabric for outside (color 1)

### Outside bottom

- 2 x Fabric for outside (color 2)

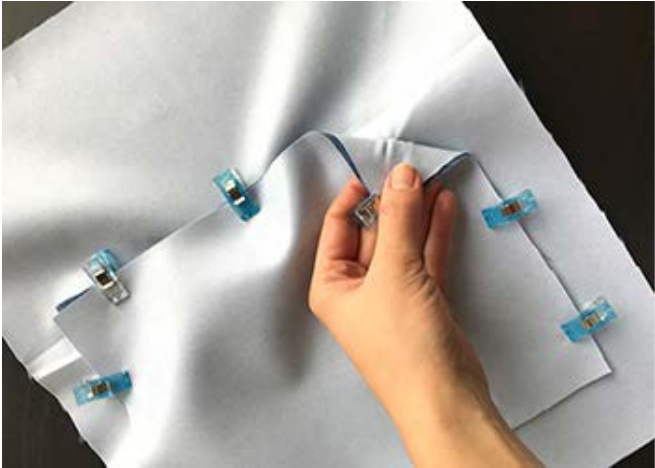
### Lining

- 2 x Fabric for inside
- 4 x H250

### Zipper compartment for inside & outside



Topstitch both layers of the zipper compartment (only the zipper compartment, not the interlining) all round with a seam allowance of 0.75 cm (0.3 inch). Fold the interlining under while sewing so that you don't accidentally sew over it.



The first zipper compartment is now ready. Sew the second one onto one of the assembled front parts of your bag in the same way. You can thread a small strip of fabric through the opening of the zipper-pull optionally and knot it.
