


Before cutting out the garment pieces, add seam allowances to the original contours: Seam allowance 1 cm /0 25/₆₄ in .Lay out the pattern pieces on a double layer of fabric (right sides facing). Fabric width140 cm /55 $^{1}/_{8}$ in

Important for e-book: "Page, Sizing and Handling" should be set to "Actual size". No scaling is required while printing. Printing orientation should be set to "Auto Portrait/ Landscape".

Please check the measure square 5 to 5 cm $(1^{31}/_{32}in to 1^{31}/_{32}in)$ matches with your printing. You can print on A4 or letter US paper.



Appliqué:Cut a piece of doublesided fusible web, slightly larger than the star appliqué.



Trace motif from pattern sheet on double-sided fusible web a fuse web to wrong side of jersey patch. Cut patch along its outlines.




Remove paper backing and fuse patch to right side of front panels





Pin tear-away backing to wrong side of front panel under appliqué patch.



Appliqué motif in place with a reinforced straight stitch or a narrow, short zigzag stich.
