Measurements of the finished piece!

All measurements in cm. Arm- and Body Lengths are inclusive of rib cuffs.
Bust and hips are measured in the circumference.

IMPORTANT STUFF:

Print all the Pattern PDF pages without scaling or fitting to the page. Make sure it prints at 100%

Please print the pages in colour, as it will be easier to distinguish the individual sizes.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU PRINT ON A4 SIZE PAPER! SOME US PAPERS HAVE DIFFERENT DIMENSIONS!

Check the 4 x 4cm control square to make sure the print is accurate.

Please orientate yourself on the layout plan to stick the pages together! You need to cut the edge off one sheet and stick it on the next one with cello tape.

Cut out the size you need after checking the size chart.

Please note that the pattern contains no seam allowance!

Always check the grainline before cutting! It is very important because it affects the way your fabric stretches. Mostly the grainline is vertical, so the stretch is horizontal. If you are not sure or cannot see it, please always stretch the fabric to see which way works best!

You are working with knitwear, so it's advisable to wash your fabrics before sewing and ironing them to avoid shrinkage!

It is advisable to read all the instructions before commencing, this way most question will be self-explanatory.
