

Cleansing Pads & Laundry Bag

About this Project

This pattern is for small cleansing pads suitable for applying make-up remover, cleansers, toners, etc, along with a mesh bag to store and launder them in. There are two designs of cleansing pad - one round, one square. Both are 6cm across, and take a tiny amount of yarn, so you will be able to make plenty, probably from odds and ends from other projects. If you make them in cotton or another hard-wearing yarn, they will give you years of service - just think of all the disposable pads you won't be putting into landfill!

Most patterns for crochet cleansing pads seem to be worked in the round. However, I have supplied a square design too because square pads have corners for careful cleansing around the eye area, plus it's quicker and easier working in rows (no increases to count!)

If you have ever seen washable cleansing pads for sale, you will find they do sometimes come with a small laundry bag. However, what you need of course is two laundry bags - one in the wash and one that you're filling as you use the pads, or even three if you want to store the clean ones in one too. That's the beauty of making this set yourself, you can make as many bags as you need.

The mesh laundry bag is designed first and foremost to be functional, and quick and easy to work, so the pattern includes a minimum of increases and counting, and no fiddly working into chains!

You could use the same bag pattern with thicker yarn and a larger hook to make a larger laundry bag for delicate underwear, etc or as an alternative to plastic bags for loose fruit and veg when shopping.
