Description

An interesting sock, knit toe-up. It combines a classic look with some more unusual elements, such as a patterned gusset. The pattern is charted, but for each chart the instructions are also written out in full, on a separate page so you can choose what to print. Please remember that these are only the written instructions *for the charts*, you will still need to refer back to the main instructions for how to move from one chart to the next.

Techniques Used

- Magic Loop
- Judy's Magic Cast On
- Jeni's Surprisingly Stretchy Bind Off
- Cables

Sizes (approx), measured around mid-foot

Small	6.5 - 7.5"/16.5 - 19 cm
Medium	8 - 9"/20.25 - 22.75 cm
Large	9.5 - 10.5"/24 - 26.75 cm



Materials

100g 4ply/fingering weight sock yarn, any that gives gauge should be suitable.

Gauge

9 stitches and 12 rows per 1"/2.5cm, measured over stocking stitch in the round.

Needles and Notions

- 2.25mm (US 1) circular needle (or whatever size is necessary to achieve gauge), 32"/80cm
- Stitch markers
- Cable needle
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

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
