

Go Faster Stripes

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Description

This fun asymmetrical shawl with picot edging can be knit in specifically chosen mini skeins, or it would be perfect for using up small amounts of any other yarn you have left over and can't bear to waste. Be sure to weigh your yarn before you start, because the colour changes are based on proportions.

Size

Different weights or amounts of yarn will impact the size. For example, the purple/grey/cream version in Holst Coast measures 64"/163cm wide and 12"/30cm deep; the blue/pink/purple version in Dibadu Funnies Simply Mini measures 80"/203cm wide and 12"/30cm deep.

Materials

Equal amount of five colours of any 4ply, fingering or light finering yarn; the heavier the weight, the more yarn you will need. Examples:

5 x 10g Holst Coast

5 x 20g Dibadu Funnies Simply Mini

Gauge After Blocking

This will vary with your yarn, aim for a nice fabric that drapes well.

Needles and Notions

- 1 pair 3.5mm/US 4 needles (or whatever size is necessary to achieve a fabric that you love)
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Abbreviations

[...]: repeat instructions in brackets
CO: cast on
C(n): colour (n)
K: knit
K2Tog: knit 2 together
KF&B: knit into front and back of stitch

LHN: left hand needle

MP: make picot - CO3, K2Tog TBL, K2Tog TBL, pass 1st st over 2nd st, K TBL, pass 1st st over 2nd st (1 st decreased)

st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop
