

# Brunswick Fingerless Mittens

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## DESCRIPTION

These fingerless mitts are a great way to use small amounts of coloured yarn. If you prefer, you could use just a single contrast colour for a striking design. The rolled edge at the top of the thumb mirrors that on the cuff, though could be swapped for a rib if preferred.

## TECHNIQUES USED

- Stranded Colourwork

## SIZE

7.5"/19cm around palm of hand. Can be adjusted by changing the gauge.

## GAUGE

8 stitches and 10 rows per 1"/2.5cm, measured over colourwork in the round on 2.75mm needles.

## MATERIALS

Jamieson and Smith 2ply jumper weight, 125 yards/114m per 25g.

MC: 36g, 180 yards/164m  
CC1: 5g, 25 yards/23m  
CC2: 4g, 20 yards/18m  
CC3: 4g, 20 yards/18m  
CC4: 2g, 10 yards/9m

Colours used in sample:

MC: Shade #2 - beige  
CC1: Shade #4 - dark brown  
CC2: Shade #12 FC - dark green  
CC3: Shade #11 FC - mid green  
CC4: Shade #1A - cream



## NEEDLES AND NOTIONS

- 2.25mm/US 1 circular needle, or dpns
- 2.75mm/US 2 circular needle or dpns (or whatever size is necessary to achieve gauge)
- Stitch markers x 2
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
