



# Philip the sheep

## Pretending he's a shepherd

**Difficulty:** ★  
**Completion:** 18 hours  
**Dimensions:**  
Height 13.4 in x width 4.7 in

**Material:**  
Wool or cotton (4.0 mm): 1 ball of beige color, 1 ball of navy-blue color  
Fluffy yarn (5.0 mm): 1 ball of white color

Characters made with the fluffy yarn *Bernat's Pipsqueak Yarn* and the yarn *Impeccable of Loops and Threads*

Security eyes 6 mm

Synthetic filling

Cotton for embroidery of brown color

Crochet hooks 3.75 mm and 4.5 mm

Tapestry needle



## Abbreviations

ch: chain stitch

scst: single crochet stitch

dc: double crochet

inc: increase – Crochet 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch.

dec: decrease - Insert hook into the front loop of the first stitch. Without yarning over, insert hook into the front loop of the second stitch. Yarn over and draw it through the first two loops on the hook. Yarn over again and draw it through the two loops remaining on the hook.

## Making of

### 1 – Head

The head is made up of the face and the ears crocheted separately.

**The face** – It's crocheted in spirals with the beige yarn (crochet hook 3.75 mm) and then with the white fluffy yarn (crochet hook 4.5 mm).

row	description	nb of stitches
Begin by the snout with the beige yarn (crochet hook 3.75 mm)		
1	6 scst in a magic ring	6
2	[1 inc, 1 scst] x 3	9
3	[1 inc, 2 scst] x 3	12
...	...	...

**Ears x2** – They are crocheted in spirals with the beige yarn (crochet hook 3.75 mm).

row	description	nb of stitches
1	6 scst in a magic ring	6
2	[1 inc] x 6	12
...	...	...

### Finishing the head

Embroider the nose with the brown cotton. Sew the ears on the head.
