This is a really sweet cardigan that combines the elements of lace knitting often seen as a traditional style but brought into modern day styling with a straight waist hemline with the cardigan sitting to the waist. The back of the cardigan and the sleeves feature subtle lace detail and with the addition of satin ribboning and cute buttons, it will look fabulous in a range of colours to suit day or special occasion outfits

ABBREVIATIONS

K2Tog – Knit 2 together YO – Yarn Over

**** Sleeve Increase in 1st and last stitch: Knit into back and front of stitch**

TENSION

28 STITCHES / 36 ROWS TO A 4" OR 10 CM SQUARE

MATERIALS

1 Ball DMC Petra 3 or equivalent cotton/yardage up to 0-3/6 mths/2 Balls 12M-2 years

4/5 buttons (depending on size)

Thread

Tapestry/Wool needle

Optional: 3mm and 5mm satin ribbon

Scissors

Tape Measure

(*) US 2.5 may be closest to metric but that most needles now carry metric sizing

EXTRACT FROM PATTERN

LEFT FRONT (AS WORN)

Using 3mm, cast on 41 stitches.

Knit the first 2 rows and stocking stitch the following 2 rows then the 1st and 2nd pattern set.

1st Pattern set

Row 1: K5, *YO, K2tog, K5. Repeat from * to last stitch, K1

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K3, *K2tog, YO, K1, YO, K2tog, K2. Repeat from * to last 3 stitches, K3

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: K5, *YO, K2tog, K5. Repeat from * to last stitch, K1

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: Purl

2nd Pattern set

Row 1: Knit 9, *YO, K2tog, K5. Repeat from * to last 4 stitches, K4.

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit 7, *K2tog, YO, K1, YO, K2tog, K2. Repeat from * to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Knit 9, *YO, K2tog, K5. Repeat from * to last 4 stitches, K4.

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: Purl

EXTRACT FROM PATTERNILY M

ALL SIZES - MAKING UP

Weave all your ends in to the back of the garment

Optional. With 3mm satin ribbon, make 4 tiny bows. Sew 2 bows to the back of the cardigan, one each above the lace pattern on either side and 1 bow each on the sleeves above the lace pattern.

Choice of cuff finish:

- 1) Fold the picot lace edge on each sleeve cuff under and stitch in place (this will give a nice finish to the cuff edge). It will shorten the sleeve by a couple of rows but nothing significant

Or: -

- 2) Weave 5mm satin ribbon through the lace work sewing the satin ribbon to each side of the sleeve on the inside.

For each sleeve, at top of sleeve, fold in half right sides together and pinch the middle. Holding the middle, pin it right sides together to the shoulder seam. Now pin one side of the underarm sleeve to the underarm front and the other side of the underarm sleeve to back armhole. Smooth out, adjust and pin the rest of the sleeve into shape on either side of the cardigan. Sew the sleeve using backstitch.
