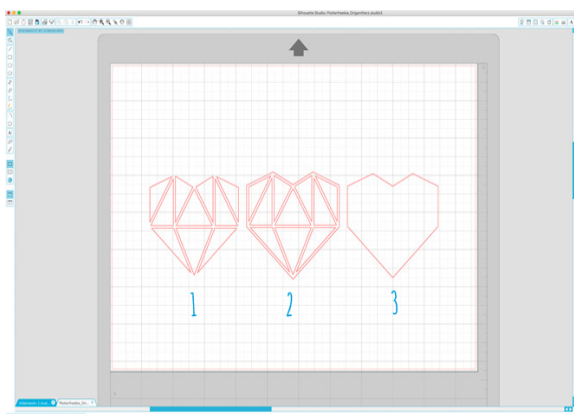
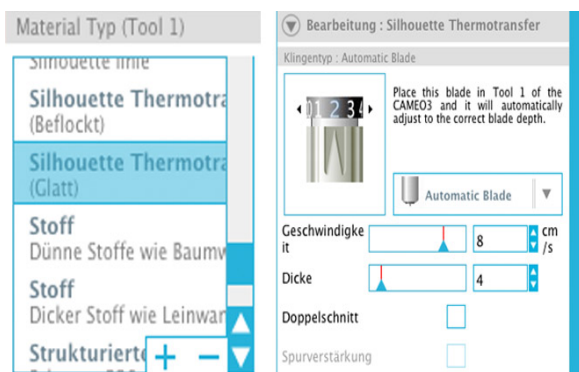
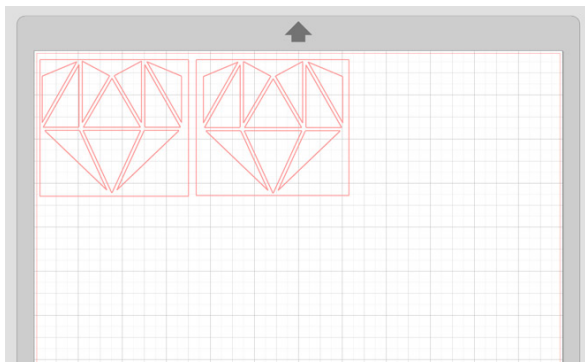
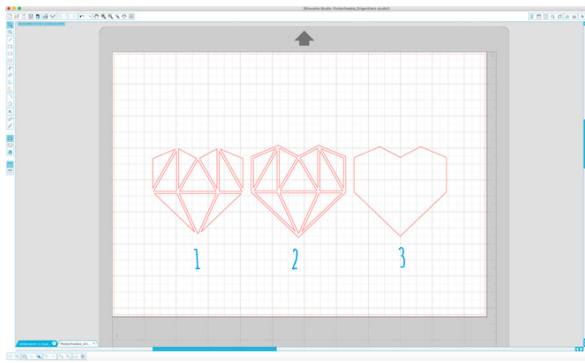


## Plotter manual: Your first Ironing-picture (suitable for beginners)



Plotting your first Ironing-picture on a flex film. The following items are required:

### For plotting:

- a plotter with cutting mat
- Tool to remove grids (pointed tweezers)
- Film in the colour of your motif
- A motif as a file suitable for your plotter.

### For applying:

- A textile (please prewash the textil without softener)
- An iron or a heat press
- baking paper
- A smooth solid support -  
NO Ironing board!

**Step1:** Open the file you want to use in the file format corresponding tto your plotter. Silhouette and Brother provide the suitable user interfaces on the internet. Mostly, you have to convert a SVG file there.

### Step 2:

 Settings in the working space:

The size of the working space depends on the settings in the software. You can do this very simply using the tab "pages settings". It makes the imagination of the size of the complete Ironing-picture easier.

**Step 3:** Create the file my Ironing-picture: To open the file you very very simply have to click on the preview picture. Or simply drag and drop it in the working space. The file is now shown in the working space, which is always underlaid in form of the cutting mat.

Directly after you have open a file, the single elements are grouped.

**This means that the single elements belong to a group and are fixed - all elements can be moved simultaneously.**

If you want to use single parts of this group, you can ungroup them.

**Just right-click on the whole motif.** A menu "ungroup" appears.
