

Fairlop

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DESCRIPTION

These toe-up socks are perfect for warmer days when you only want a short sock. Use a summery yarn and you'll have your favourite new summer socks. The socks have an Eye of Partridge heel flap and a patterned cuff.

The pattern is written with instructions for Magic Loop but there is no reason why you shouldn't knit with another style of needle if that is your preference.

TECHNIQUES USED

- Magic Loop
- Judy's Magic Cast-On

SIZES (TO FIT), MEASURED AROUND MID-FOOT

- Small 7"/17.75cm
- Medium 8"/20.25cm
- Large 9"/22.75cm

All sizes allow for approx 1"/2.5cm negative ease for a comfortable fit.

MATERIALS

100g HiKoo by skacel's CoBaSi - 55% cotton, 21% nylon, 16% bamboo, 8% silk, 220 yds/201m per 50g

You may be able to make smaller sizes with a single 50g skein - the sample pair are size Medium, with a 9"/22.75cm long foot and took 65g. The sample is in colour 47 - Really Red.

Alternatively, any 4ply/fingering weight sock yarn that gives gauge will be suitable.

GAUGE

9 stitches and 13 rows per 1"/2.5cm, measured over stocking stitch in the round.

NEEDLES AND NOTIONS

- 2.25mm/US 1 circular needle (or whatever size is necessary to achieve gauge), 32"/80cm
- Stitch markers x 2
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends
