



## Richmond Mitts

These pretty fingerless mitts use an unusual zigzag rib combined with a single cable on the top of the hand. They use less than half a 100 gm skein, so treat yourself (or someone special) to something beautiful and practical.

### DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

### SIZES

S/M and M/L (choose larger size for looser fit or large hands)

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 5.5 (6.5) in/14 (16.5)cm, unstretched and 8 (9)in/20 (22.5)cm stretched, around palm of hand; 8 in/20 cm from top edge to hem.

### YARN

Unwind Yarn Company - Luxe Sock, 80% merino wool, 10% nylon, 10% cashmere; 100g/435 yd/400 m; Graphite, 1 skein.

### NEEDLES

US 2 - 2.75 mm, DPNs or 2 circulars, 24 - 32 in./ 60 - 80 cm, or size required to achieve gauge.

### GAUGE

32 st and 36 rows = 4 in/10 cm in st st.

### NOTIONS

Stitch markers  
Cable needle  
Yarn needle

### PATTERN NOTES

The rib pattern is quite stretchy, so the mitts will fit most hands.



### HELPFUL HINTS

It's suggested to use 2 circulars or magic loop, rather than DPNs, in order to keep the cable pattern all on one needle; but it can be knit on DPNs if you like.
