Tips

If you are sewing this pattern for the first time, don't forget you can try out the fitting as many times as you need to.

Hemming

There is an allowance of 2 cm for the hem in the pattern. There is an allowance of 1 cm for the hem on the lateral edge on the back panels. If you want a wider hem there, make note of this when cutting.

Neckline

The neckline is designed for a cuff. If you want to sew bias tape, the neckline could become too big. Therefore, check beforehand.

As there are different requirements (e.g. for autumn or summer) for the size of the neckline, you may need to adjust or change it.

What are the notches/markings for?

The markings in the pattern are there so that you know exactly where the back and front panels meet, or which side of the sleeves need to face forward. It is therefore important to always transfer the markings to the fabric. You can do this with either a marking pen or by making small notches with scissors into the seam allowance.

Selecting the size

Finding the correct width

Measure the circumference of your child's chest and then find the corresponding width on the table.

If your child normally wears clothing size 110, do not be confused if you now come to the width of 92, as, after all, the top should sit as well as possible.

Always use the size that comes the closest to your reading.

EXAMPLE

If your child has a chest circumference of 58 cm, then use size 110. The idea that one size bigger lasts longer is good but it can lead to the top being just too wide meaning it no longer looks good when it is worn.



- 1 Arrange your cut segments.




- 2 Sew a hem of 1 cm around the edge of the inner edges of the back segments.
