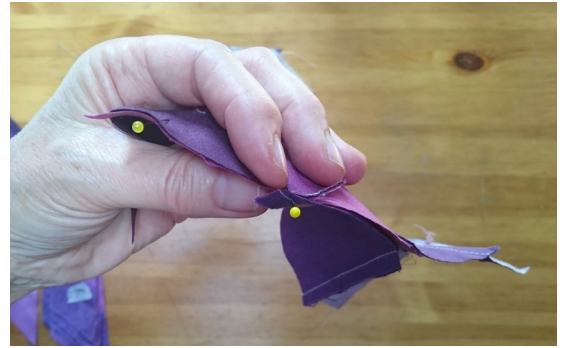


11. The pin should be inserted exactly at the cross-over point of the two seams. The seam allowances will go in opposite directions to each other.

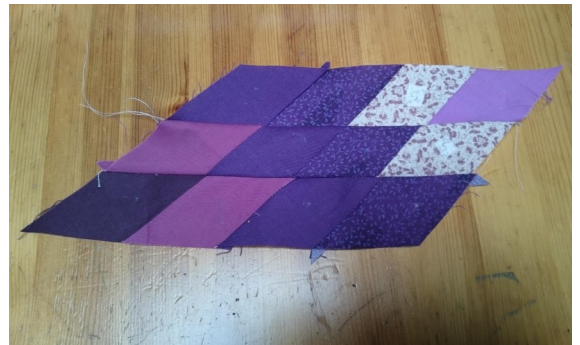


12 Stitch with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm) seam, taking care not to stretch the pieces.

Press twice as before. NB keep the iron well away from any masking tape labels or remove the tape temporarily while ironing.



13 Place a C/D/E/F strip right sides together, on top of the B/C/D/E strip. Pin, stitch and press as in steps 11 and 12.



14 Place a D/E/F/G strip right sides together, on top of the C/D/E/F strip. Pin, stitch and press as in steps 11 and 12.

This completes one of the 'arms' of the star. The dark purple point (Fabric A) will be on the outside) and the patterned mauve diamond (Fabric G) will be at the centre.

Repeat steps 10 to 14 seven more times to make 8 'arms' in total.



15. Add a large triangle of Fabric H (cream) on one side of the star 'arm' and a small triangle of Fabric H on the other side as shown in the photo. Look at the photo for step 17 to ensure the triangles are correctly placed.

In step 17, you will be joining this piece to the next one, along the side marked with a line of dashes in this photo.
