6 Take a look at the pieces in pile W and put the fabrics in a pleasing order (decide which piece looks nice next to the fabric alongside it).

When you are happy with your arrangement, put pile X, pile Y and pile Z into the same **order** of fabrics as your first one. (This takes a little while, but it will be worth it!)



7 Place your four piles of fabric on a table top or tray. Leave pile W as it is. Take one piece of fabric off the top of pile X and place it at the bottom of the pile (see photo).



8 Take two pieces of fabric off the top of pile Y and place them at the bottom of the pile.



9 Take three pieces of fabric off the top of pile Z and place them at the bottom of the pile.



10 You should end up with piles of wedge-shaped pieces which look something like the ones in the photo.
