This cozy, textured hat has super insulating powers and will keep you toasty warm. A simple combination of knits, purls, and slipped stitches, the Waffle Rib stitch creates delicious texture and thickness for a comfortable and sophisticated look that any knitter can achieve.

Sizes

To fit: 16 ½ (18 ½, 20, 22, 24)" / 42 (47, 51, 56, 61) cm

Finished Measurements

Circumference: 13 ¾ (16, 18 ¼, 20 ½, 22 ¾)" / 35 (40.5, 46.5, 52, 58) cm

Depth: 6 ¼ (7, 8 ½, 9 ¾, 11)" / 15 (18, 20.5, 23, 28) cm, not including pom-pom

Intended to be worn with negative ease. Choose a finished size about 1.5-3" (4-7.5 cm) smaller than head.

Materials

Bulky weight yarn; 130 (155, 195, 235, 275) yd / 120 (140, 175, 215, 255) m (includes pom-pom)

Shown here: 1 (2, 2, 2, 2) balls Knit Picks *Wool of the Andes Superwash Bulky*; 137yd (125m) per 3.5oz (100g); 100% Superwash Wool; in Indigo Heather

Needles & Notions

4.5 mm (US 7) double pointed needles plus 16" (40 cm) circular needle, or two 24" (60 cm) circular needles for two circulars technique, or one 32" (80 cm) or longer circular needle for Magic Loop technique

Stitch marker; yarn needle; 4" (10 cm) pom-pom maker or cardboard template

Gauge

14 sts and 35 rounds = 4" (10 cm) over Waffle Rib in the round, blocked

15 sts and 40 rounds = 4" (10 cm) over Waffle Rib in the round, unblocked

Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.





Finishing

Weave in ends, wash and block to dimensions.

Pom-pom

Make a 4" (10 cm) pom-pom and secure to top of hat.

Abbreviations and Stitch Glossary

k	Knit
k2tog	Knit two sts together
p	Purl
sl	Slip stitch
st(s)	Stitch / stitches
