Therefore and to celebrate "Feli's" fifth anniversary, we decided to optimise your favourite cutting pattern, to make it bigger and to personalise it even more - so we brought you a complete makeover.

Regardless, if you're an old "Feli" lover or if it's a newly inflamed passion - with "Feli", you are well served, all over the year and from toddlers just finding their feet through to cool teens.

In this ebook, you will find everything you need in order to sew the coolest "Feli" of all times. The ebook contains a

regular hood, either with a round shape or a pointed shape, a widely overlapping fluffy hood as well as the option to add a neckband to your "Feli".

You can use jersey or sweat fabrics for your "Feli".

Regarding the different fabrics, I will provide additional tips in the section "cutting pattern". Furthermore, you can choose between the popular "Feli" side pockets, with the option of sewing visible or invisible pockets with pouches, as well as with a small or big kangaroo pocket.

Additionally, there is a regular sleeve and a puffy sleeve, various options for eyelets, cord strings and smaller add-ons. Be surprised!

It doesn't always have to be a new cutting pattern, you can also just warm up your old love affair. Those dishes that are left to stand for a while and reheated later are still the best.

And now: get felichanted!

Due to the different variations and fabric options, I highly recommend reading through the entire guide first. In the chapter "sewing variations", I will go more into detail regarding the different pattern pieces, types of fabric and variations.

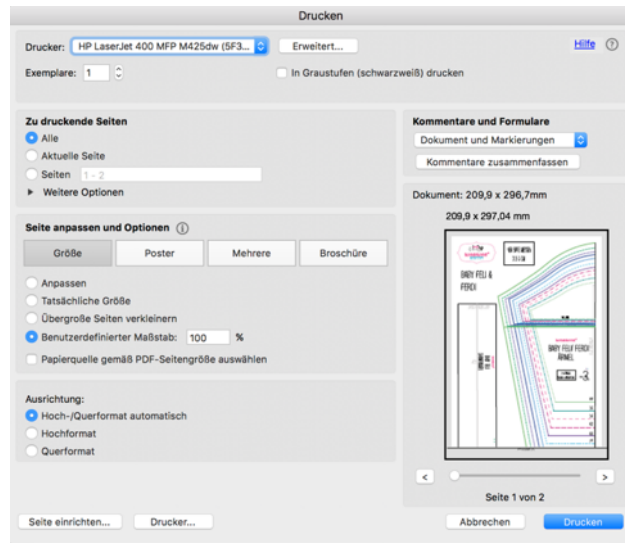

PRINTING THE CUTTING PATTERN:

If you are printing the cutting pattern on your PC, make sure that the page adjustment is turned off and the pattern will be printed in its original size. There is a control box on each part of the pattern that you can use in order to check if the printed size matches the actual size. For an ideal printing result of the cutting pattern, your printer should be configured to “print in portrait and landscape”, but most printers do this automatically anyway. If you are unable to print the guide, it is probably due to the volume since many printers cannot handle such big documents. In this case, please contact marie@rosarosa.eu - she will be happy to help you with this issue.



WHAT YOU NEED:

In order to make this tunic, it is best to use a sweatshirt or jersey fabric, but you could also use knitted fabrics or jacquard. If you are unsure about the size, you can use the measurements of the next lower size, just in case you are using a very thin or elastic fabric and your child is rather small. For normal weight children and if you are using average fabrics, that are not too thick nor too thin (such as cotton jersey or summer sweat), the tunic will turn out in the correct size.

You can finish the lower hem with a wide band or, as an option, with a tunnel for a cord string or an elastic band. The cut is rather generous, so for free spirits, there will be enough freedom of movement. My ebooks are always based on the child's body height, so it is best to choose the closest size, e.g. 88 cm body height -> size 86 // 90 cm body height -> size 92 // 95 cm body height -> size 98.

I recommend working with pre-washed fabrics or, in case your fabrics are not pre-washed, cutting out your pattern one size larger. When working with jersey etc. you should expect a shrinkage of approx. 3-5% and it would be a shame if your tunic stops fitting too quickly - the little ones grow up too fast anyway.

BASIC INSTRUCTION FOR "FELI" WITH FLUFFY HOOD AND SIDE

POCKETS

LEVEL **



ALL INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDED IN THIS GUIDE ARE BUILT ON THIS INITIAL, BASIC INSTRUCTION. IN THIS PART, I WILL SHOW YOU HOW TO SEW ON THE CUFFS AND HOW TO CLOSE THE SIDES. FURTHERMORE, WE ARE GOING TO CREATE THE FLUFFY HOOD IN THIS PART OF THE GUIDE, WHICH, IN THIS SPECIFIC EXAMPLE, INCLUDES AN ADDITIONAL CORD STRING. ALSO, I WILL SEW THE TUNIC WITH THE CLASSIC "FELI POCKETS".



Cutting pattern including cuffs, pockets and cord strings.

As marked in the cutting pattern, I cut out the pocket opening + seam allowance from the front part.

We'll begin with the pockets. Why? Because we should always start with the decoration of the front part, regardless if it is a kangaroo pocket, sectioning, side pockets etc. This way, the front part will be already finished and ready for the further steps.

First, take your pattern piece for the pocket band, fold it over and iron it lengthwise, wrong sides together.

If you want to leave out the pockets, skip to page 6.
