Baby (Stroller, Lap, Throw, Twin, Full/Queen)

Shown in Throw size.

Finished Measurements

Baby: $25 \frac{1}{2} \times 33 \frac{1}{2}$ " (65 × 85 cm); **Stroller:** $30 \frac{3}{4} \times 40 \frac{1}{4}$ " (78 × 102 cm); **Lap:** $35 \frac{3}{4} \times 47 \frac{1}{4}$ " (91 × 120 cm); **Throw:** $44 \frac{1}{4} \times 58 \frac{3}{4}$ " (112.5 × 149 cm); **Twin:** $57 \frac{1}{2} \times 81 \frac{1}{2}$ " (146 × 207 cm); **Full/Queen:** $81 \frac{1}{4} \times 90$ " (206.5 × 228.5 cm)

Needles & Notions

6 mm (US 10) 32" (40 cm) or longer circular needle plus DPNs, or size to obtain gauge

Stitch markers; 6 mm (J-10) crochet hook; smooth waste yarn; yarn needle

Materials

Bulky weight yarn

Main colour: 475 (655, 855, 1345, 3165, 4365) yd / 435 (600, 785, 1230, 2895, 3990) m

Contrasting colour: 350 (500, 675, 1110, 2850, 3970) yd / 320 (460, 620, 1015, 2605, 3630) m

Shown in Knit Picks *Chroma Twist Bulky* (bulky weight, 70% Superwash Wool, 30% Nylon; 127 yards/100g) in Lupine and Get Your Neon

Gauge

14 sts and 20 rows = 4" (10 cm) over Stockinette st, blocked

Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.
