

# Doll outfit with Ruffles

## PDF Crochet pattern



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## Foreword

The pattern includes step-by-step illustrated instructions how to crochet ruffles dress. You can create a very big collection for your doll using this pattern and different colors of yarn. This dress looks fantastic any way!

You crochet the dress from the top down in one piece. There is no need to sew, accept the zipper and decoration if you wish.

You can crochet this jumpsuit with cotton or any other yarn your choice.

Skill level: Easy to Intermediate

This dress is actually not difficult to make, but you should have already crocheted several projects before you start with this.

You will need to crochet following easy stitches: chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, slip stitch. You should also can crochet 2 DC together.

The list of contents helps you to jump in any step of instructions without scrolling all over the pattern (just click the point needed).

I always try to make my patterns as perfect as possible.

## Materials needed

- Color 1: Cotton yarn 125 m / 50 grams (approx. 60-70 grams)
- Color 2: Cotton yarn 560 m / 100 grams (approx. 10-20 grams)
- Crochet hook size 2.00 and 2.25 cm

## Abbreviations

CH – chain

DC – double crochet

SC – single crochet

SLST – slip stitch

RST – raglan stitch

## Notes

(please read all notes before you start and if something is not clear in the instructions, please check these notes again)

- You will make the dress in one piece first in rows, starting with the neck and then in rounds, making the skirt.
- Each row or round starts with chain 2 (counts as 1st double crochet). Further on in the instructions these 2 chains are not mentioned separately (e.g. if you read at the beginning of the row "Crochet 7 DC", it means "chain 2 counts as 1st double crochet, and 6 double crochet".
- Do not forget to turn at the end of the row.
- By crocheting in rounds, each round always ends with a slip stitch, to join the beginning and end of round.
- If it is not mentioned separately, it means that 1 stitch (e.g. 1 double crochet) is worked in the following stitch. If you read "10 DC", it means you should make 1 double crochet in each of the following 10 stitches.
- You crochet normally working through both loops of the stitch. It will be extra indicated if you should crochet working through back or front loop only.
- Increase - you make 2 chains (e.g. 2 DC) in the next same stitch
- (=N) – the number of stitches in the row or round in total

## Gauge

with crochet hook size 2.00 Cm and yarn 125 metres / 50 grams:

24 DC = ca. 10 cm (approx. 3,94 inch)

Change hook size if necessary, to obtain gauge.

## The beginning. Rows 1-5

Crochet CH 50 with color 1 and crochet hook size 2.00 cm

Raglan-Stitch (further „RST“) crochet as follows:

1 DC + CH 1 + 1 DC in the same stitch

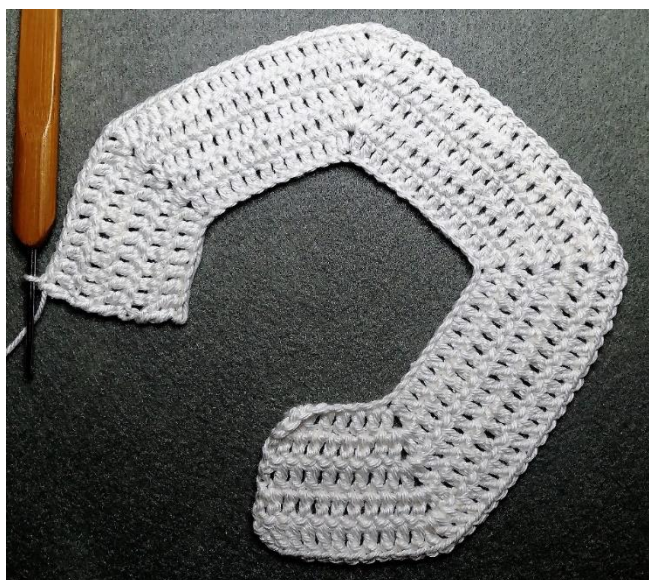
Row 1:

7 DC, RST, 10 DC, RST, 12 DC, RST, 10 DC, RST, 7 DC



Row 2 - 5: 1 DC in each DC of the previous row, and crochet in each of 4 chain spaces of RST always again 1 RST

After crocheting of Row 5 you should have 86 DC and 4 CHSP.



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
