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Foreword

The pattern includes step-by-step illustrated instructions how to crochet doll outfit for 18-inch dolls. There are 2 variants: a dress/hat outfit and a top/skirt/hat outfit with a sweet bonus: a hair decoration. You can create a very big collection for your doll using only this pattern and different colors of yarn. Your doll will be very pretty any way!

You crochet the dress from the top down in one piece. There is no need to sew the parts, you should just sew buttons and decoration if you wish.

You can crochet this outfit with cotton or any other yarn your choice.

Skill level: Easy to Intermediate

This outfit is actually easy to make, but you should have already crocheted several projects before you start with this.

You will need to crochet following easy stitches: chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, slip stitch.

The list of contents helps you to jump in any step of instructions without scrolling all over the pattern (just click the point needed).

I always try to make my patterns as perfect as possible.

Materials needed

- Yarn for the yellow dress and hat: 125 m / 50 gram, approx. 110 gram,
- Yarn for the purple top-skirt-hat variation: 125 m / 50 gram, approx. 115 gram
- Crochet hook size 2,75
- 6 small buttons approx. 7-8 mm (about 3 inch)

Abbreviations

CH – chain

CHSP – chain space

DC – double crochet

SC – single crochet

SLST – slip stitch

Notes

(please read all notes before you start and if something is not clear in the instructions, please check these notes again)

- ❖ You will make the dress in one piece first in rows, starting with the neck and then in rounds, making the skirt.
- ❖ Each row or round starts with chain 2 (counts as 1st double crochet). Further on in the instructions these 2 chains are not mentioned separately (e.g. if you read at the beginning of the row "Crochet 7 DC", it means "Chain 2 counts as 1st double crochet, and 6 double crochet".
- ❖ By crocheting in rounds, each round always ends with a slip stitch, to join the beginning and end of round.
- ❖ Do not forget to turn at the end of the row.
- ❖ V-group: make (1 double crochet + chain 1 + 1 double crochet) in the same stitch.
- ❖ To change yarn color in rows, work last double crochet as follows: yarn over with old color, insert hook in the next (usually last) stitch of previous row, yarn over, pull the hook through the chain, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops on hook, and now yarn over with new color and draw through last 2 loops on hook.
- ❖ To change yarn color in rounds, work last double crochet of round with old color, then working joining slip stitch as follows: insert hook in first double crochet of round (in highest chain of chain 2 count as 1st double crochet), yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete joining slip stitch.
- ❖ If it is not mentioned separately, it means that 1 stitch (e.g. 1 double crochet) is worked in the following stitch. If you read "10 DC", it means you should make 1 double crochet in each of the following 10 stitches.
- ❖ Increase – double crochet (or single crochet) twice in the same next stitch.
- ❖ (=N) – number of stitches in the row or round in total.

Gauge

with crochet hook size 2.75 cm and yarn 125 metres / 50 grams:

20 double crochet = 10 cm (about 3,94 inch)

Change hook size if necessary, to obtain gauge.

The beginning. Row 1.

Picture 1. Crochet each row with different colors.

Crochet CH 50 with color 1.

Row 1: 7 DC, V-group, 10 DC, V-group, 12 DC, V-group, 10 DC, V-group, 7 DC.

By making the last DC, make the color change (work the last 2 loops on the hook with the new color. See the Notes above for more details).



Cut the first yarn leaving 5-7 cm /2-3 inch. You can hide it later with the yarn needle as on the picture 3 (weave in) or put the end parallel to the row and crochet it into the next row as on the picture 4)

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
