

Doll outfit Top-Skirt-Scarf PDF crochet pattern



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Foreword

The pattern includes step-by-step illustrated instructions how to crochet a top, a skirt and a scarf for 12-inch dolls. You can create super collection for your doll using only this pattern and different colors of yarn. This set looks cool any way!

You can crochet this doll set with thin cotton or any other thin yarn your choice.

Skill level: Easy to Intermediate

This set is actually not difficult to make, but you should have already crocheted several projects before you start with this.

You will need to crochet following easy stitches: chain stitch, single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, treble crochet, slip stitch.

The list of contents helps you to jump in any step of instructions without scrolling all over the pattern (just click the point needed).

I always try to make my patterns as perfect as possible.

Materials needed

Crochet yarn (cotton or any other, 560 metres / 100 grams)

Crochet hook size 1 cm or 1.25 cm

(if you crochet tight – crochet hook size 1 cm, if loose – 1.25 cm)

Beads approx. 0.15-0.20 inch (4-5 mm)

Abbreviations

CH – chain

SC – single crochet

hDC – half double crochet

DC – double crochet

TC – treble crochet

CHSP – chain space

SLST – slip stitch

[] – Group of stitches to repeat

Notes

(please read all notes before you start and if something is not clear in the instructions, please check these notes again)

- ➔ Each row starts with chain 1 (counts as 1st single crochet) or chain 2 (counts as 1st double crochet or chain 3 (counts as 1st treble crochet). Further on in the instructions these e.g. 2 chains are not mentioned separately (e.g. if you read at the beginning of the row "Crochet 7 DC", it means "chain 2 counts as 1st double crochet, and 6 double crochet".
- ➔ Do not forget to turn at the end of the row.
- ➔ If it is not mentioned separately, it means that 1 stitch (e.g. 1 double crochet) is worked in the following stitch. If you read "10 DC", it means you should make 1 double crochet in each of the following 10 stitches.
- ➔ You crochet normally working through both loops of the stitch. It will be extra indicated if you should crochet working through back or front loop only.

Top

Crochet CH 20. As from here crochet working through back loops only.

Row 1 - 9: crochet 20 SC.



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
