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## Foreword

The pattern includes step-by-step illustrated instructions how to crochet Ballerina dress for 12-inch dolls. You can create a very extended collection for your doll using this pattern and different colors of yarn. This dress looks fantastic!

You crochet the dress from the top down in one piece. There is no need to sew. Lacing at the back side of dress is used both for easy dressing and as a nice decoration.

You can crochet this dress with cotton or any other lace yarn your choice. You can also use your leftover yarn.

**Skill level:** ♥ ♥ ♥ ♥ ♥

Easy to Intermediate. This dress is actually not difficult to make, but you should have already experience with lace yarn.

You will need to crochet following stitches: chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, slip stitch.

The list of contents helps you to jump in any step of instructions without scrolling all over the pattern (just click the point needed).

I always try to make my patterns as perfect as possible.

## Materials needed

- Crochet yarn lilac and violet (560 m / 100 g) – approx. 20 Gramm (120 metres).
- Crochet hook size 1,50
- Yellow satin ribbon approx. 0.12 inch (3 mm) wide, approx. 15-19 inch (40-50 cm)

## Abbreviations

CH – chain

DC – double crochet

SC – single crochet

SLST – slip stitch

## Notes

(please read all notes [before you start](#) and if something is not clear in the instructions, please [check these notes again](#))

- You will make the dress in one piece first in rows, starting with the neck and then in rounds, making the skirt.
- Each row or round starts with chain 2 (counts as 1st double crochet) or chain 1 (counts as 1st single crochet). Further on in the instructions these chains are not mentioned separately (e.g. if you read at the beginning of the row "crochet 7 DC", it means "chain 2 counts as 1st double crochet, and 6 double crochet" or if you read „crochet 5 single crochet“, it means „chain 1 counts as 1st single crochet and 4 single crochet“).
- Do not forget to turn at the end of the row.
- By crocheting in rounds, each round always ends with a slip stitch, to join the beginning and end of round.
- If it is not mentioned separately, it means that 1 stitch (e.g. 1 double crochet) is worked in the following stitch. If you read "10 DC", it means you should make 1 double crochet in each of the following 10 stitches.
- Increase - you make 2 chains (e.g. 2 DC) in the next same stitch
- Decrease – crochet 2 chains together
- [...] – the group of chains to repeat
- (=x) – the number of stitches in the row or round in total

## Gauge

with crochet hook size 1.50 and yarn 560 metres / 100 grams:

32 double crochet = about 4 inch (approx. 10 cm)

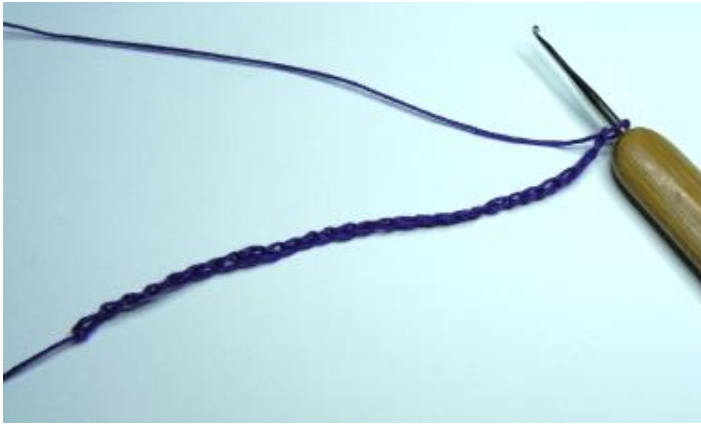
Change hook size if necessary, to obtain gauge.

## Finished measurements

The dress fits 12-inch dolls. The length of dress is about 4 – 4.5 inch.

## The beginning. Rows 1-3

Start with chain 28 (violet color yarn).



ROW 1: 28 DC (=28).



ROW 2: 10 DC, Increase, 2 DC, Decrease, 2 DC, Increase, 10 DC (=29).
