Knitting pattern by Cheryx



NEEDLES

 A pair of 2.75mm (US 2) straight knitting needles

MATERIALS

- Toy filling (less than 50g)
- Tapestry needle
- Pins
- A piece of carton (or book)
 in size 20 cm by 15 cm (8" x 6")

YARN

- Wishful bird baby of Ruyi Bird
- 78% cotton, 22% Acrylic
- 50g 130m

Less than 25g in each colour:

- Light beige 15
- Plum 7
- Purple 9
- Yellow 8
- Pink 17
- Black 3



NOTES

- Finished size: The finished Doll is 13cm tall
- **Gauge:** 26 sts and 34 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stockinette stitch. Don't worry too much about tension for this pattern.
- Work flat: All pieces are knitted flat (back and forth) on a pair of straight knitting needles.
- **Casting on:** Unless otherwise specified, I prefer to use the long tail cast on for all pieces.
- **Sewing seams:** Use Mattress Stitch to sew the seams.
- Safety: If you are making these toys to give to a child, please consider your choice of toy eyes carefully, and ensure you have no loose parts (loose threads, buttons, etc) which can be potential

ABBREVIATIONS

K Knit

P Purl

K2tog *Decrease:* Knit two stitches

together

Kfb *Increase:* Knit into the front

and back of the next stitch

P2tog *Increase:* Purl two stitches

together

K3tog *Decrease:* Knit three stitches

together

st(s) Stitch(es)

rep Repeat

Stocking Stitch (St-st)

Knit all stitches on right side rows, purl all

stitches on wrong side rows

(.. sts) The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the

number of stitches after working the row.

[...] Repeat the sequence between the square brackets by the number

indicated.

Pull through to cast off

Cut the yarn leaving at least a 30cm tail. Thread the tail onto a tapestry needle and sew through the remaining sts on the knitting needle. Pull the sts off the knitting needle on to the yarn, gather together

tightly and secure the yarn.

KNITTING PATTERN

HEAD & BODY OF THE DOLL (Make 1)

Start on the top of the head

Cast on 9 sts in light beige

Row 1: P8 (8 sts)

Row 2: K1, KFB x6, K1 (14 sts)

Row 3: P14 (14 sts)

Row 4: K1, [K1, KFB]x6, K1 (20 sts)

Row 5: P20 (20 sts)

Row 6: K1, [K2, KFB]x6, K1 (26 sts)

Row 7: P26 (26 sts)

Row 8: K1, [K3, KFB]x6, K1 (32 sts)

Row 9: P32 (32 sts)

Row 10: K1, [K4, KFB]x6, K1 (38 sts)

Row 11: P38 (38 sts)

Row 12: K38 (38 sts)
