

1 Make the left side of the stocking.

Take one $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$ " (72 x 72mm) square of fabric J and one of fabric K. Draw a line diagonally across the J square on the wrong side.

Place the J square right sides together with the K square.

2 Pin the un-marked corners and stitch on either side of the line, $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm) away from the line.

3 Cut along the line.

4 Press the seam, then open the triangles and press again, pressing the seam allowances over towards the darker side.

Repeat steps 1-4 once more.

5 Join a J/K square to a $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " (63 x 63mm) fabric J square and then add a K/J square, as shown in the photo.

Press the seam allowances away from the white central square.
