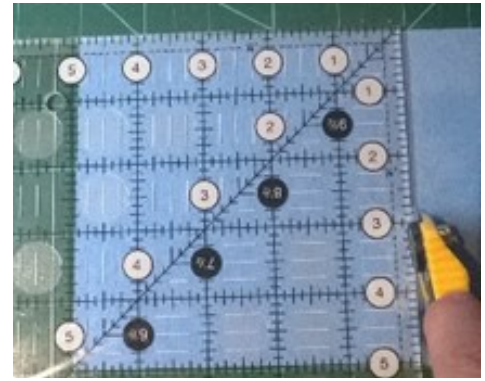
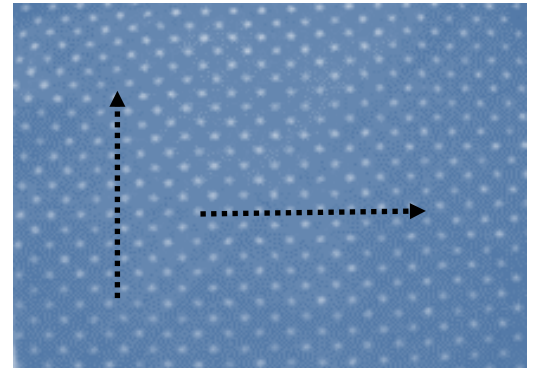

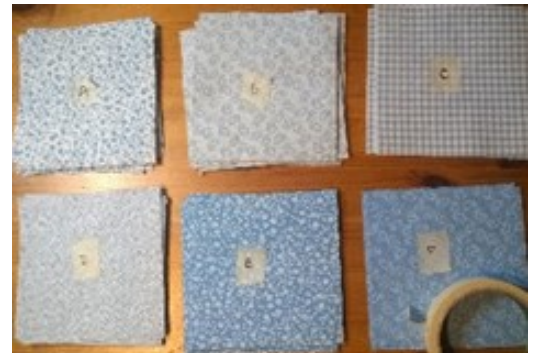
1. **To make the blue baby quilt top:** Cut 12 squares, each 5 x 5" (127 x 127mm), from each of the following fabrics: A, B, C, D and E (not F!). Use a ruler to mark out measurements, cut with a rotary cutter. **To make the pink baby quilt top:** follow steps below, but refer to the pink quilt key below the chart on the opposite page.



2. Cut along the straight grain of the fabric. (Grain lines follow the threads in the weave - marked by white arrows on the photo right.)



3. Label each pile with the correct letter (written on masking tape, stuck to the top square).



4. Trace letters for HELLO BABY! from the back page onto tracing paper and cut out. Letter L is within E (two needed). Pin patterns to fabric F (on the straight grain, indicated by arrow on pattern). Lay pattern pieces with care, so they all fit onto fabric F.



5. Attach each letter to a square of fabric B. Start with the first letter (H) and pin it carefully onto the fabric, making sure that it is placed so there is an even distance on either side of the letter. Then hold it in place with a tacking stitch (a temporary stitch which holds fabric in place until it is sewn).
