

Doll outfit „Glamour“ PDF Crochet pattern



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Foreword

The pattern includes step-by-step illustrated instructions how to crochet doll dress "Glamour" and a Cap for 18-inch dolls. You can create one or several dresses for your doll using these detailed row-by-row instructions. This dress looks fantastic! You crochet the dress from the top down in one piece. There is no need to sew the parts together.

I explain you how to crochet long sleeves too.

Optional: you can decorate this dress with beads, crochet flowers or like me satin ribbons.

Skill level: ♥ ♥ ♥ ♥ ♥

Easy to Intermediate. This dress is actually not difficult to make, but you should have already crocheted several projects before you start with this.

You will need to crochet following stitches: chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, slip stitch.

Language: English (US terms).

The list of contents helps you to jump in any step of instructions without scrolling all over the pattern (just click the point needed).

I always try to make my patterns as perfect as possible.

Materials needed

- Cotton yarn 145 m / 50 grams - approx. 55 grams (e.g. Miracle 145 m / 50 gr or Catania 125 m / 50 gr from Schachenmayr)
- Crochet hook size 2.75 cm
- 2 small buttons approx. 7-8 mm (0.28-0.30 inch)
- Satin ribbon

Gauge

with crochet hook size 2.75 cm

and yarn 145 metres / 50 grams: 19 double Crochet = about 4 inches (approx. 10 cm)

and yarn 125 metres / 50 grams: 20 double Crochet = about 4 inches (approx. 10 cm)

Change hook size if necessary, to obtain gauge.

Finished measurements

The dress fits 18-inch dolls. The length of dress is variable.

Notes

(please read all notes before you start and if something is not clear in the instructions, please check these notes again)

- You will make the dress in one piece first in rows, starting with the neck and then in rounds, making the skirt.
- Each row or round starts with chain 2 (counts as 1st double crochet). Further on in the instructions these 2 chains are not mentioned separately (e.g. if you read at the beginning of the row "Crochet 7 DC", it means "Chain 2 counts as 1st double crochet, and 6 double crochet".
- Do not forget to turn at the end of the row.
- By crocheting in rounds, each round always ends with a slip stitch, to join the beginning and end of round.
- If it is not mentioned separately, it means that 1 stitch (e.g. 1 double crochet) is worked in the following stitch. If you read "10 DC", it means you should make 1 double crochet in each of the following 10 stitches.
- V-Group - you make 1 DC + CH 1 + 1 DC in the next same chain
- Increase - you make 2 chains (e.g. 2 DC) in the next same stitch
- (=x) – the number of stitches in the row or round in total

Abbreviations

CH – chain

DC – double crochet

SC – single crochet

SLST – slip stitch

Dress. Row 1

Crochet CH 53.

Row 1: 7 DC, V-Group (s. Notes above and picture below), 10 DC, V-Group, 15 DC, V-Group, 10 DC, V-Group, 7 DC.
