Dots Dabbles

(Dated: v1.0 – September 25, 2020)

The Rúmil cowl is a unisex pattern, featuring a simple yet stunning geometric pattern. This colourwork motif was originally inspired by the patterning of some concrete floor tiles on a pathway I often passed.

Yarn: About 65 grams of fingering weight sock yarn in 2 contrasting colours: 40 grams of MC and 25 grams of CC. Pick 2 solid colours with good contrast for the best effect

Yarn used in sample is Tukuwool Fingering (75% Finnsheep and 25% Texelin, 213 yards or 195 meters per 50 grams) in colourways Raku (MC) and Uupo (CC)

Gauge: 28 stitches and 36 rounds is 4 inches or 10 cm in stranded stockinette stitch

Needles: 2.75 mm (US 2) or size needed to obtain gauge in stranded stockinette stitch, and needles that are one size smaller

Materials needed: Needles for working small circumferences in the round, at least 1 stitch marker, and a tapestry needle

Techniques used: Stranded colourwork

Size: Circumference of about 22 inches or 55 cm, height of about 9 inches or 23 cm
