



# NEAPOLITAN TANK

## PATTERN NOTES

- The top is meant to be worn with 0"- 2" negative ease. It looks adorable layered over bralettes or a swimsuit top with some high-waisted shorts or skirts.
- It is initially constructed in one piece from the top down using a provisional cast-on for the straps. The back is added using a cabled cast-on. The lace at the waist is knit perpendicular to the body of the top.
- There's an opening left at the back of the lace for a peek-a-boo effect.
- You can easily adjust the length of the top to make it shorter or longer before working the lace trim portion.
- **Note:** When making straps, measure a favorite top or bralette for correct length!

## FINISHED BUST CIRCUMFERENCE

Size 1 (XS): 28.8"/73 cm  
Size 2 (S): 32"/81.2 cm  
Size 3 (M): 35.2"/89.5 cm  
Size 4 (L): 38.4"/97.5 cm  
Size 5 (XL): 44.8"/113.8 cm  
Size 6 (2XL): 48"/122 cm  
Size 7 (3XL): 51.2"/130 cm  
Size 8 (4XL): 54.4"/138.2 cm

## NOTIONS

Stitch markers  
Darning needle  
Scissors  
Waste yarn

## YARN

For sizes: 1 (2, 3, 4) (5, 6, 7, 8)  
160 (222, 264, 327) (395, 470, 550, 636)yards  
146 (203, 242, 300) (360, 430, 502 580)m

Caron Cotton Cakes (Worsted Weight (4); 60% Cotton/ 40% Acrylic; 100g/211 yards/193m).

1 (2, 2, 2) (2, 3, 3, 3) skeins.

Color used: Rose Whisper

## SUGGESTED NEEDLES

US 8 (5 mm) circular needles, 24" (61 cm).

## GAUGE

17 sts x 27 rows = 4"/10cm with US 8 (5mm)  
in stockinette stitch, blocked

Please be sure to check gauge before as well as during your project to ensure a good fit when the top is completed.
