POLLY PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Polly is a semi-fitted skirt with a straight silhouette. The skirt is designed with two flounces over the lining and an elastic waistband. Polly is above-knee length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this skirt, choose dress-weight and suiting fabrics with the following properties:

- · lightweight to medium weight, structured and non-stretch
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (silk, cotton, linen), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (cotton+ viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester)
 - · the following fabrics are recommended: satin, poplin, linen, cotton eyelet fabric, cotton shirting

Attention! We do not recommend using stretchy knit fabrics. The fabric must be structured.

The garment in the photo is made of cotton eyelet fabric. This fabric is medium weight, non-stretch, and structured. The fiber content is 100% cotton.

The lining is made of cotton shirting. The fiber content is 100% cotton.



IMPORTANT! When purchasing fabric, please account for shrinkage and buy 5% more than required.

5. Matching thread — 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker)



Pin the side seams of the top and bottom flounces, baste and machine-stitch. Backstitch at the beginning and end.



Overlock the seam allowances. Keep the back piece facing up. Press the seam flat.



Press the seam allowances towards the front.
