The #41 bloomers is a cozy and versatile companion for girls and boys!

The pants with dividing seam can be stitched with or without ruffle. Additionally, the cut contains seam pockets and an attached pocket on the backside pants.

The hem's cuff can be made with or without the button detail.

During our tryout sewing French terry revealed itself to be the most useful kind of fabric. The cuffs at the waistband and hems are best made from ribbing. The ruffle can be made from jersey knit or ready lace ribbons. The instructions are showing you once the ruffle doubled and once single layered with a rolled hem. Before cutting, have a look at the design examples at the end of the instructions, there you will find many different finishing.

This pattern contains the sizes 56 - 140. If you are not sure which size to choose, have a look at the explanation for fitting. The pattern contains a diaper and a usual version.

The pants is cut casual with a low crotch. Of course, all children are built differently. Some are having a longer upper body, a little baby fat or are rather slim built. Best you compare the length and width with a well-fitting jogging/bloomer pants or measure the width and length at your child. Measure before cutting the ribbing the waist. If your child is very slim, you can cut the ribbing a little shorter.

The instruction is very elaborate and rich in pictures to enable sewing beginners to achieve. Please read the instructions once completely before starting to sew!

The materials you need:

For constructing the paper pattern parts, you need a printer, paper scissors, adhesive tape and a measuring tape.

To sew the pants you need apart from your sewing machine (serger or cover machine if available), French terry, jersey knit (or lace ribbons) for the ruffle and the pattern parts of the side seam pockets, buttons for decoration at the hem cuff, ribbing, fitting yarn, stitching needle, pinning needles or fabric clips, fabric scissors or rotary cutter and cutting mat. Additionally, it is recommended to use wondertape for applying the pockets and ruffles.

It is recommended to pre-wash the fabric before using to prevent shrinking!

If necessary use tailor's chalk or fabric markers to transfer the pattern onto your fabric or to transfer other marks.

Of course, you can add applications, plotted pictures and other embellishments.



Constructing your paper pattern parts:

First of all, print the paged for your pattern chart. Choose for printing the "real size" and check the check box with a measuring tape.
