

SORELLE PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Sorelle is a pair of lined, semi-fitted, A-line shorts. The back features waist darts. There are pockets in the side seams. Sorelle fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam. The waistband has a hook-and-eye closure. The scalloped hem is finished with lace trim. Sorelle shorts are above mid-hip length.

- 4. One pair of trouser hook-and-eye fastener.
- 5. Stitched straight fusible stay tape, 1 cm (3/8") wide 0.6 m (5/8 yd).
- 6. Stitched fusible stay tape with stitch reinforcement, 1.5 cm (5/8") wide 0.5 m (1/2 yd).
- 7. One 25 cm (9 7/8") long invisible zipper.
- 8. Matching thread 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker).



Pin the dart on the wrong side of the back leg piece.



Machine-stitch the dart, backstitching at the top edge only. Tie the thread tails at the dart point into a knot and hide them inside the dart bulk using a needle.



Press the dart seam flat.
