

## Crochet pattern pillow with ice cone stitch - with American crochet terms

Treat yourself to lots of ice cream!

## About the pattern:

- The pillow consists of 2 parts of $40 \times 40 \mathrm{~cm} / 16 \times 16$ inch that are crocheted together
- The chains at the beginning of a row do not count as a stitch
- After a color change, leave the old color hanging on the wrong side of the pillow until you need it again in that row. When you use this color again don't pull it too hard or leave it too loose. This is to prevent the stitches from 'pulling' or creating gaps between the stitches

Level: Intermediate (I assume that you know how to change colors in a row)
Size: 1 size: $40 \times 40 \mathrm{~cm} / 16 \times 16$ inch
Materials:

- Hook D 3 (= 3mm)
- Yarn with yarn weight fine / sport / baby (e.g. SMC Catania) in 3 colors:
- 1 for background = light green (color 00385): 210 grams = 525 meters / 575 yards
- 1 for cone = light brown (color 00437): 60 grams = 150 meters $/ 165$ yards
- 1 for ice = white (color 00105): 80 grams $=200$ meters $/ 220$ yards
- Pillow insert $40 \times 40 \mathrm{~cm} / 16 \times 16$ inch
