The nineteenth dream

Needles

- A pair of 2.25mm straight knitting needles
- A pair of 2mm straight knitting needles

Materials

- Toy filling (less than 50g)
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Sewing pins
- 3 Holders
- 2 Markers
- 2 beige button size (size 1cm)
- 2 black button (size 1cm)
- A piece of carton in size 4x20 cm
- 1 Crochet hook (< size 2,25)


Yarns


Less than 50g in each colour:


- Scheepjes Stone Washed

 Beige 871

- Jeans - Yarn Art

 Orange 85

 Green 69

 White 01

 Black 53

 Gray 46



Notes

- **Finished size:** The finished doll is 30cm tall
- **Gauge:** 26 sts and 34 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stockinette stitch. Don't worry too much about tension for this pattern.
- **Work flat:** All pieces are knitted flat
- **Casting on:** Unless otherwise specified, I prefer to use the long tail cast on for all pieces.
- **Sewing seams:** Use Mattress Stitch and Whip Stitch to sew the seams.

Abbreviations

K	Knit
P	Purl
Kfb	<i>Increase:</i> Knit front and back
K2tog	<i>Decrease:</i> Knit two stitches together
K3tog	<i>Decrease:</i> Knit three stitches together
SSK	<i>Decrease:</i> Slip a stitch (as if to knit it) to the right needle, slip a second stitch in the same way, slip both stitches together back to the left needle and knit together through the back loops.
KRL	<i>Increase:</i> With your right needle, come from behind and scoop up the right loop of the "V" stitch just below the one on your left needle. Lift this loop up into your left needle. Knit the loop.
KLL	<i>Increase:</i> After working a knit stitch, identify the stitch 2 rows below the one on your right needle. With your left needle, come from behind to scoop up the left loop of this stitch. This loop on the left needle is the new stitch. Insert the right needle tip through the back loop and knit.
WS	Wrong side
st(s)	Stitch(es)
St st	<i>Stockinette Stitch:</i> Knit all stitches on right side rows, purl all stitches on wrong side rows.
(...sts)	The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the number of stitches after working the row.

Knitting Pattern

Head (Knit 1 piece)

Cast on 8 stitches with beige yarn (leave a long tail for sewing).

Row 1: K1, KFB x6, K1 (14 sts)

Row 2 (WS): K

Row 3: K1, (K2, KLL) x6, K1 (20 sts)
