DIANA PATTERN DESCRIPTION

Diana is a semi-fitted dress with an accentuated waist and a skirt that flares out towards the bottom. The dress is fitted with front and back princess seams. The back has shoulder darts transferred to the neckline. The front features pockets at the sides. The dress has a round neckline and voluminous, elbow-length, set-in sleeves. The sleeves feature pleats at the caps and darts at the hems. The hems of the sleeves are finished with facings. The dress is finished with a free-hanging lining and fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam. Diana is midi length.

SUGGESTED FABRIC

To sew this dress, choose dress-weight and suiting fabrics with the following properties:

- · medium weight, structured, breathable, low-stretch or non-stretch, with good drape
- the fiber content can include natural fibers (wool, silk, cotton, linen), artificial fibers (viscose), blends (wool + silk, wool + polyester, cotton + viscose, etc.), and synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane)
 - the following fabrics are recommended: dress-weight wool, dress-weight denim, jacquard fabrics

Attention! We do not recommend stretchy knit fabrics and lightweight sheer fabrics (chiffon, organza, stretch lace).

For the lining, we recommend artificial fibers (viscose), blends (viscose + elastane, viscose + polyester), and synthetics (polyester, polyester + elastane).

The dress in the photo is made of dress-weight wool. The fabric is medium weight, with good drape and very little stretch. The fiber content is a blend of wool, viscose, and elastane.

The lining is 97% viscose + 3% elastane.

- 3. Lightweight knit or woven interfacing, 140 cm (55") wide, for all sizes in all heights 0.3 m (3/8 yd)
- 4. Stitched bias-cut fusible stay tape with stitch reinforcement, 1 cm (3/8") wide, for all heights:

- 5. Stitched straight-grain fusible stay tape 0.3 m (3/8 yd)
- 6. Stiff net fabric, 140 cm (55") wide, for all sizes in all heights 0.5 m (1/2 yd)
- 7. One invisible zipper, 60 cm (23 5/8") long, for all sizes in all heights
- 8. Matching thread 5 spools (1 spool for the sewing machine + 4 spools for the overlocker)

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine for construction
- overlocker for finishing raw edges. It can be replaced with a stretch overlock stitch or a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine (overlock or zigzag stitch width 2–3 mm, stitch length 2.5 mm)
- stitch-in-the-ditch foot for the sewing machine (optional)
- invisible zipper foot for the sewing machine
- · one-sided foot for the sewing machine

After assembling the garment, press it lightly and press the seam allowances either to one side or open.

What to look for during fitting?

The left and right sides of the garment should look the same.

Verify the garment balance: the side seams, center back and center front lines should be vertical, the shoulder seams should lie on the natural shoulder line.

The back should not ride up. There should be no horizontal folds at the back and no tension at the shoulder blades and shoulders.

Check the fit of the sleeve. The sleeve should lie smoothly, without folds or wrinkles.

Check for fit issues associated with individual features of the body.

After the fitting, make changes symmetrically to both sides of the garment; if needed, baste once more for another fitting.



Pin and baste the shoulder dart on the wrong side of the back piece. Machine-stitch with backstitches at the beginning of the seam.

Leave long thread tails at the end, tie them into a knot and hide them inside the dart bulk using a large-eye needle.



Press the dart flat.
