**Crochet Terms:** US terminology throughout

**Skill Level:** Easy Intermediate

### Yarn and Colors Used:

- I Love This Cotton (Worsted Weight), 100% cotton
- Yarn Bee ~ Pima Suprema Yarn (Worsted Weight), 100% cotton
- Yarn Bee ~ Cotton Et Lin (Worsted Weight), 80% cotton, 20% linen
- ◇ [Colorway 1](#), **A** – Parchment (I Love This Cotton); **B** - Sage (I Love This Cotton); **C** – Coral (I Love This Cotton)
- ◇ [Colorway 2](#), **A** - Olive (I Love This Cotton); **B** – Bone (Yarn Bee ~ Pima Suprema); **C** – Mauve (Yarn Bee ~ Cotton Et Lin); **D** - Merlot (Yarn Bee ~ Pima Suprema)

**Additional Items Needed:** Stitch markers and yarn darning needle

yo (Yarn over)

sc (Single crochet)  
hdc (Half double crochet)  
BPhdc (Back post half double crochet)  
dc (Double crochet)  
FPdc (Front post double crochet)

BPdc (Back post double crochet)  
2dc-cluster (2 double crochet cluster)  
tr (Treble crochet)  
2tr-cluster (2 treble crochet cluster)  
EXT-puff  
3LP (3rd loop of stitch)
