Peropherical series sweet shirting soft freed torry fabric Lining fabrics:

Recommended fabrics: sweat-shirting, soft french terry fabric. Lining fabrics: jersey


Lay out the pattern pieces on a double layer of fabric (right sides facing). Fabric width  $140 \text{ cm} / 55^{1}/_{8} \text{in}$ .

Knitted cuffs: fabric width 82 cm/329/32in, fabric 32 cm/1219/32in,

Please look at the cutting plan!

**Important for e-book:** "Page, Sizing and Handling" should be set to "Actual size". No scaling is required while printing. Printing orientation should be set to "Auto Portrait/ Landscape". Please check the measure square 5 to 5 cm ( $1^{31}/_{32}$ in to  $1^{31}/_{32}$ in) matches with your printing. You can print on A4 or letter US paper.



#### Please note:

The instructions are shown in two different sorts of fabrics.

### Variant A and B

The first thing to do is sew the pocket on the front of the sweatshirt (this is totally optional by the way) To do this, pin the outer fabric and lining right sides together and sew all around. Leave the lower side open.





Cut back the seam allowances of the curves and corners of the bum pocket.



Turn the pocket over and iron it.
